We refer to the above matter, wherein we act for the Green Connection.


We note from various media reports that the National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) has approved electricity generation licenses for three Karpowership SA projects in Saldanha Bay, Coega and Richards Bay.

We are instructed to request, as we hereby do, that NERSA provides our client with its written Karpowership SA electricity generation license decisions, including the legal and factual basis and the reasons for these decisions.

We point out that in terms of section 10(1) of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004, every decision of the Energy Regulator must be in writing and (among other things) be explained clearly as to its factual and legal basis and the reasons therefor.

We look forward to receiving NERSA's written decisions for the three Karpowership electricity generation license decisions, including the legal and factual basis and the reasons therefor, by return of email.
